**ADVERTISEMENT FOR ENGAGEMENT OF RETIRED PEONS / GROUP-D
EMPLOYEES (CONTRACTUAL) FOR REVISIONAL COURTS UNDER BOARD OF
REVENUE, ODISHA, CUTTACK.**

Applications in the prescribed format (enclosed herewith) are invited from the interested **retired Peons /Group-D Employees** not above the age of **65** years and having experience and good service records and physical fitness for engagement of **11 (Eleven) retired Peons /Group-D Employees** on contractual basis in the Revisional Courts under Board of Revenue, Odisha, Cuttack in pursuance of G.A Department Resolution No. 23750/Gen Dated 27.08.2014.

2. The contractual engagement shall be made initially for a period of **one year** or till the vacant post are filled up on appointment or promotion, whichever is earlier.
3. The terms and conditions are subject to codal provisions, memoranda and Resolution issued by the Finance Department from time to time.
4. The appointee has to discharge such duties and in such a manner, as may be prescribed by Board of Revenue from time to time.
5. The retired Peons /Group-D Employees against whom a Vigilance case or Departmental Proceeding or Criminal Prosecution is contemplated or pending or who has been penalised for misconduct during the period of preceding five years of his/her retirement, or is a member of a political party will not be considered for re-engagement.
6. Consolidated Remuneration of the contractual officers/employees shall be fixed after consultation with Govt. in Finance Department/ Revenue & DM Department.
7. The period of contractual engagement shall not be counted as Government service for the purpose of pension and any other retirement benefit.
8. The engaged retired Private Secretary/Personal Assistant will be subject to and will abide by the Conduct Rules applicable to the Government Servants.
9. The contractual engagement may be terminated at any time by the Member, Board of Revenue for unsatisfactory performance , on notice of one month, and in case of any misconduct including, but not limited to, misappropriation , negligence or causing loss to Government, without any prior notice.
10. In case the engaged employee desires to resign from the engagement, he/she may do so by giving a notice of one month in writing to the Member, Board of Revenue. After expiry of the notice period, he/she may be relieved after handing over full charges of records to the relieving officer as decided by the Member, Board of Revenue.

11. The Member, Board of Revenue reserves the right to reject any/ all applications without assigning any reason thereof.

12. The application complete in all respect in the enclosed FORMAT should be addressed to the Member, Board of Revenue, Odisha, Cuttack and should reach the office within 15 days from the date of publication of the advertisement.

Applications received thereafter shall not be entertained.
